The GABV Leadership Academy is a **transformative learning experience** for senior professionals in **values-based financial institutions**. The programme is offered by the Global Alliance for Banking on Values (GABV) in partnership with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) Co-Lab and Presencing Institute. Titled ***Resilience in the face of polycrisis***, it focuses on leadership tools and methods that enable participants to lead and innovate during periods of disruption and high complexity.

The programme sits at the intersection of **personal development and system transformation**. It is designed to develop leaders to step into their **full potential** and **deepen their impact** in their respective organisations.

Participants explore concepts and **best practices in values-based banking** as well as successful business models from around the world. They engage with thought leaders, entrepreneurs and business leaders who innovate to **achieve triple-bottom-line success**. On completion of the programme, participants join a thriving international community of values-based bankers, the GABV Alumni group.

Blended Online/ in-Person format

The 12th edition of the GABV Leadership Academy will take place from January to October featuring six online sessions and two in-person modules. The first in-person meeting will be held alongside the 2027 **GABV Annual Meeting hosted by Bank Australia in Melbourne** (11-17 April). We offer a second in-person module in October 2027 to deepen the learning. We are currently looking for a host bank and will let you know the exact time and location as soon as possible.

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KEY OBJECTIVES

- Using **state-of-the-art leadership methodologies**, including the Theory U concept developed at the **MIT Sloan School of Business**, learn and practice tools and methods for leading in times of disruption.
- In a reflective and challenging learning environment, develop **leadership skills** and identify personal **leadership intention**.
- Through interactions with thought leaders, activists and business leaders, participants deepen their understanding of the **systemic forces** that underpin current disruptions.
- **Prototype solutions** that enable institutions to survive the shocks created by the converging crisis we live in.
- Acquire and strengthen the **leadership capabilities and practices** needed to create a positive social and ecological impact.

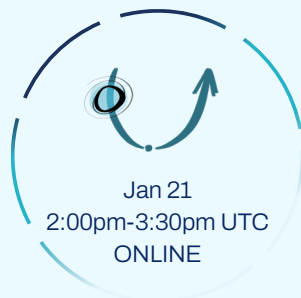
THE APPROACH

The programme follows the method and framework of **Theory U**, developed by Otto Scharmer at MIT 20 years ago. Theory U is about personal leadership and a different way of thinking.

The programme addresses leadership 'blind spots'

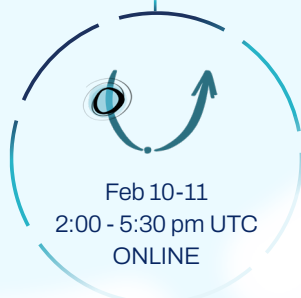
- by **shifting the inner place** from which leaders operate when confronted with disruption; instead of relying on past experiences, learn to innovate from the emerging future;
- by **experimenting** with practices, processes and ways of being in order to respond to challenges.

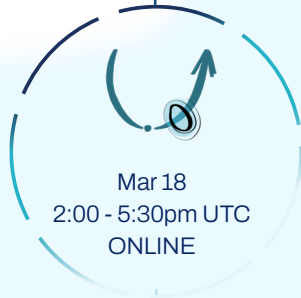

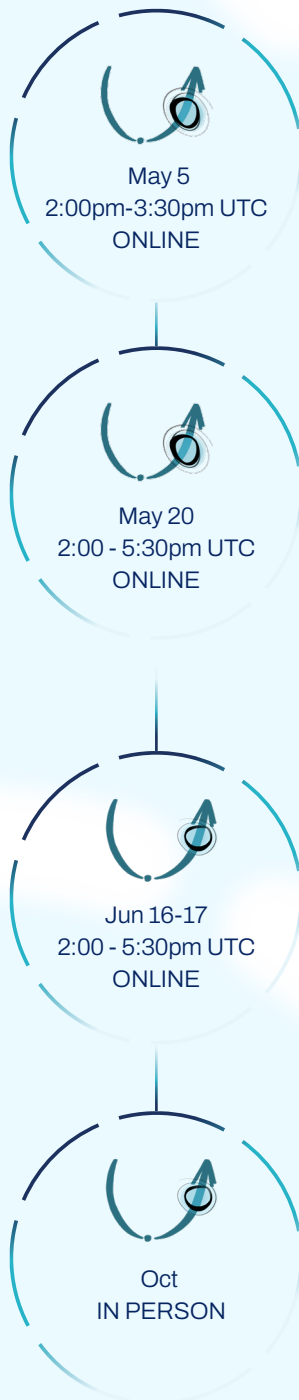

The GABV Leadership Academy is supported by a team of experts from the Presencing Institute, MIT and the Global Alliance for Banking on Values. In every edition, a number of high-level thought leader fields participate as guest speakers.

WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

The GABV Leadership Academy is for courageous, values-oriented leaders who want to actively co-create a future that considers the well-being of people and planet.

It is designed to be interactive and engaging, providing a safe space for peer learning and deepening connections to oneself and the other participants.

A prerequisite for participation is, therefore, a commitment to attend all the modules and to fully engage in the experience. Participants are expected to be on time, have their computer's camera turned on, and be willing to share and contribute. The ability to log on from a location without major interruptions is important.

The GABV Leadership Academy is a transformative learning experience. Participants should demonstrate a readiness to look inward, be open to new ideas and show interest in thinking of innovations in values-based banking. Most importantly, they should be committed to advancing the ideas and practices of Values-Based Banking.

REQUIREMENTS

- At least three years leading a bank or financial institution, a department, a team, or a major project
- Commitment to fully participate
- Submission of a short written reflection on:
 - > 2–3 career milestones
 - > main professional challenges
 - > motivation to participate

PREREQUISITES

Much of the programme is delivered online via Zoom. Access to a stable internet connection and to Zoom is a necessity.

English will be the primary language of the programme. Participants must have an adequate level of proficiency in English.
